## General Information

Applications to the [Honours program](#) are only accepted from students currently enrolled in the [BA Applied Psychology program](#). This program is designed for completion in the last year of a student's degree. Students should typically apply for the BA Applied Psychology program once they have completed about 60 credits, then apply for the Honours program going into their last year. Students must submit two applications for the Honours program ([College admissions](#) and this PSYC Department form). Both are due by April 30 before their Honours year. Use this [checklist](#) as a guide to help plan and track progress on your degree. Please review the following information before deciding whether to apply:

1. The Bachelor of Arts in Applied Psychology-Honours program is intended to provide students with additional self-directed psychological research experience, which may aid in the pursuit of further training in graduate programs.
2. In order to apply, students must have **written commitment (below) from a faculty member** in the Department of Psychology at Douglas College who agrees to supervise the Honours Thesis.
3. Students typically apply to the Honours program once they are at about the 75-credit level in the BA Applied Psychology program. Students must first be accepted into the BA Applied Psychology program before they are eligible to apply for the Honours program.
4. Douglas BA Applied Psychology students must submit their honours application by **April 30** for Fall entry. Honours courses run Fall-Winter only. There is only one cohort per calendar year.
5. Admission to the BA Applied Psychology Honours program is very competitive and has very limited capacity. In order to be admitted, students must achieve a **cumulative GPA of 3.33**.
